

Jesus Displays His Power over Demons February 3-5, 2018

(Mark 1:21-28) They went to Capernaum, and when the Sabbath came, Jesus went into the synagogue and began to teach. {22} The people were amazed at his teaching, because he taught them as one who had authority, not as the teachers of the law. {23} Just then a man in their synagogue who was possessed by an evil spirit cried out, {24} "What do you want with us, Jesus of Nazareth? Have you come to destroy us? I know who you are--the Holy One of God!" {25} "Be quiet!" said Jesus sternly. "Come out of him!" {26} The evil spirit shook the man violently and came out of him with a shriek. {27} The people were all so amazed that they asked each other, "What is this? A new teaching--and with authority! He even gives orders to evil spirits and they obey him." {28} News about him spread quickly over the whole region of Galilee.

- 1. Do you believe that there are people today who are physically possessed by an evil spirit? Why/why not?
- 2. What are come traits displayed by those who suffer from demon possession (in the Bible or today)?
- 3. When Jesus taught in the synagogue in Capernaum, how did the people react?

- 4. What do you think made Jesus' teaching "different?" (cf. Matt. 5:21, 27, 31; John 8:26; John 1:17-18; John 7:16-17)
- 5. What do you learn from what the evil spirit said to Jesus (v. 24)?
- 6. Give some possible reasons why Jesus silenced the spirit's "true" confession about him?
- 7. What similarities/differences do you see between this account and the one in Mark 5:1-20?
- 8. Agree/disagree: "Satan manipulates the truth." Defend your answer.
- 9. Why do you think demon possession is not more common in our world today?
- 10. What should the Christian's attitude toward the Devil and his demons be? (cf. 1 Peter 5:8-9; 1 John 3:8; Col. 2:13-15; Rev. 12:7-11)
- 11 Where is the warning in this text/sermon? Where is the comfort?
